


Naming

Soriani got called to serve in the Second World War, and didn't come back. Until he died, Fido went to the bus stop every day and waited for Soriani. He died waiting at the bus stop.

Fido became a popular news story, was awarded a gold medal by the mayor, and even featured in Time Magazine in 1957.
